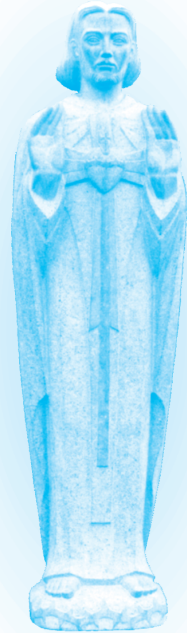

Fourth Sunday Of Easter

Acts 4:8-12/1 Jn 3:1-2/Jn 10:11-18

I know a fellow who was a missionary. He spent years in Africa. In the middle of a career change, as he headed into the classroom, he taught me something. The Church is, by its very nature, missionary.

"Read Ad Gentes!" he said. That Second Vatican Council text, the Decree on the Mission Activity of the Church, asserts that the faithful must work together to build up the Body of Christ as quickly as possible (36). This is strong—even urgent—stuff. How is it supposed to look? Should we go out two by two, door to door? Do we witness silently? How will people know what our message is? Ad Gentes 15 adds that the first and best step we can take is to live a deeply spiritual Christian life.

Missionaries could have a lot of different looks, a lot of different day jobs. Some might be experts in theology. Some might build businesses. Some might start conversations. Some might inspire quietly. Some will look like Christ serving others, looking for him, trying to serve him.

Another Vatican II document, Dogmatic Constitution on the Church (Lumen Gentium), says Christ gives the people of God the faith and grace to share the message of the Gospel through their everyday activities (35).

John Henry Newman (1801-1890) wrote about *sensus fidei*—a sense of faith—calling it an "instinct." Newman says it is linked to apostolic teaching, is the work of the Holy Spirit, is an answer to prayer, and is a jealousy of error. This is strong stuff fueling us for strong work.

We are all responsible for the Gospel.
